

# Pollack Watering Event 2022/23 Notes – March 12<sup>th</sup>

## Delivery

- Delivery of managed recession continues at a reduced rate via inlet #1 only
- A total of 75ML was delivered last week
- Water depth at the swamp centre is 0.770m, a fall of 30mm for the week
- Extent of inundation has receded to 125ha (Figure 3).

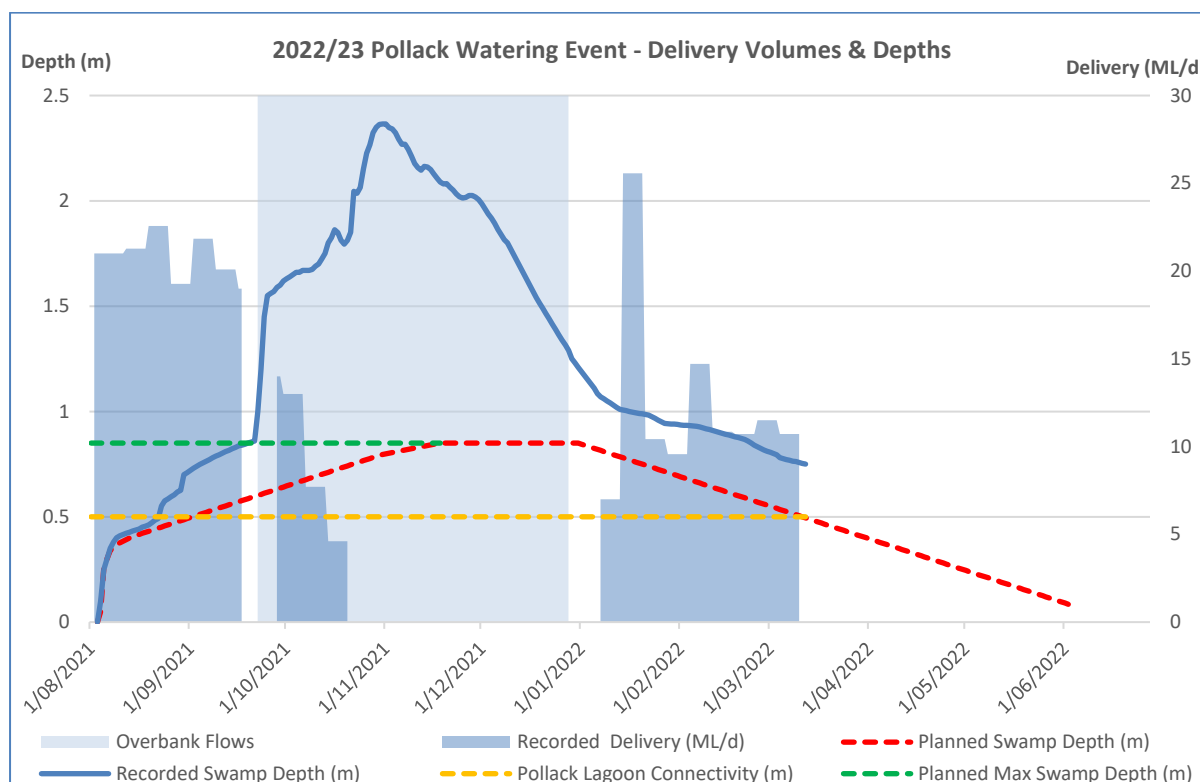


Figure 1: Graph indicating the average delivery rate (ML/day), planned and recorded depths (m) at the swamp centre.

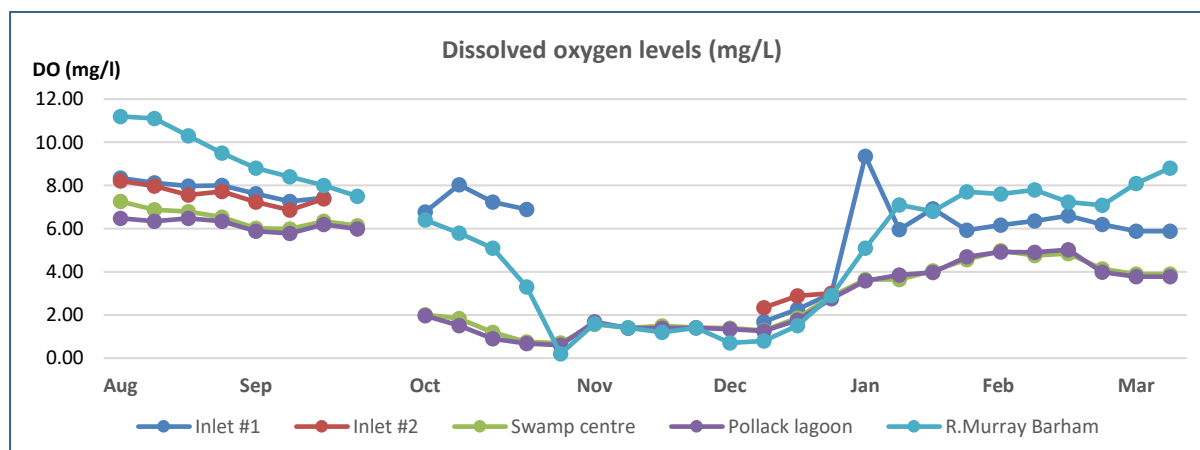


Figure 2: Dissolved oxygen levels (mg/L) recorded at four sites at the Pollack and the Murray River Barham.

- Fox control program has commenced.

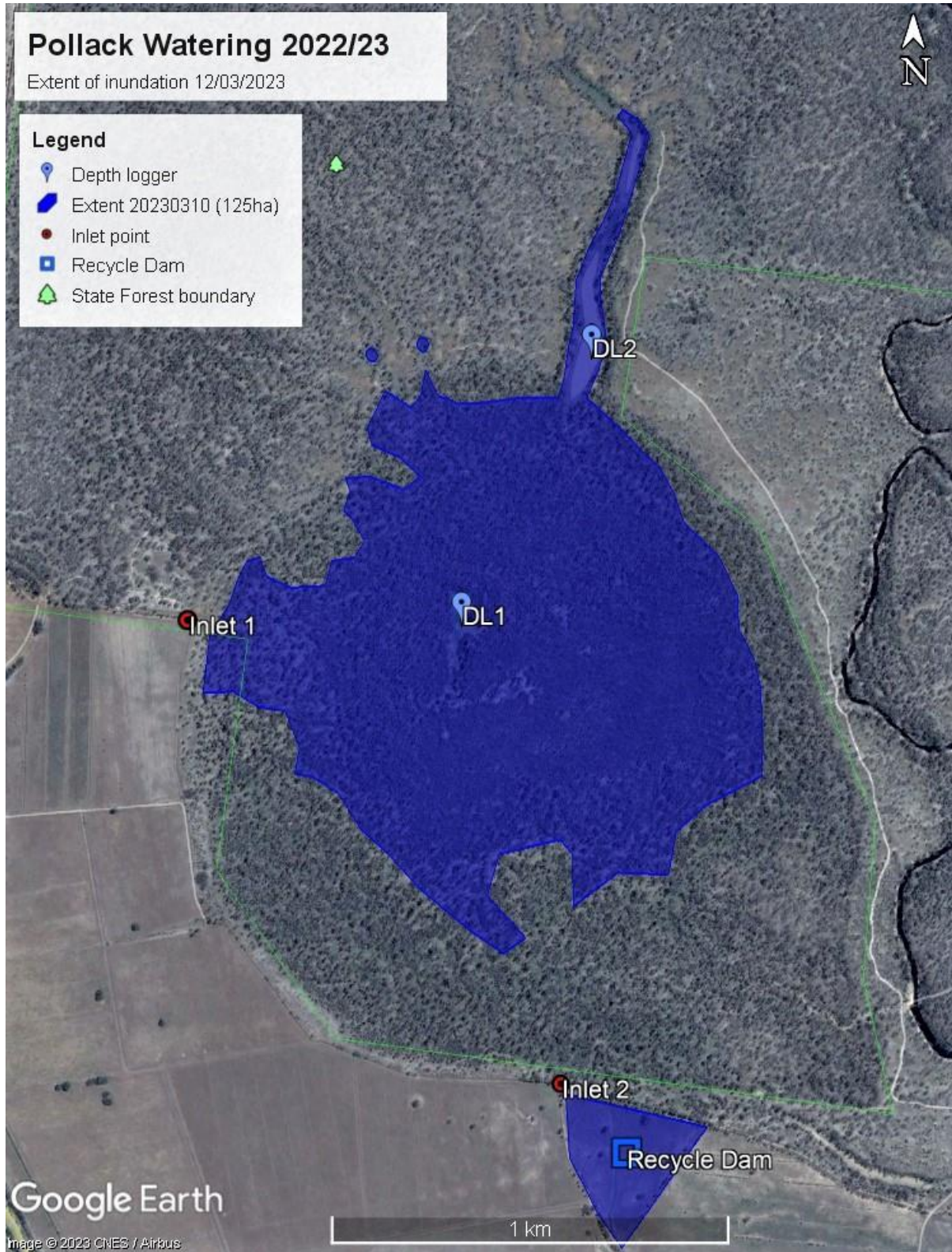


Figure 3: Map indicating the location of inlet points, depth loggers and recorded extent of inundation.
